

ORDINANCE NO. 71

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA, TEXAS PROTECTING THE WATER SUPPLY OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA BY MEANS OF SANITARY CONTROL.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Zavalla is obligated to provide the citizens of Zavalla a sanitary water supply.

**WHEREAS**, the construction and operation of underground petroleum and chemical storage tanks and liquid transmission pipelines, stock pens, feedlots, dump grounds, privies, cesspools, septic tank or sewage treatment drain fields, improperly constructed water wells of any depth, and all other construction or operation that could create an unsanitary condition within, upon, or across the property subject to this ordinance are prohibited within this easement. For the purpose of the ordinance, improperly constructed water wells are those wells which do not meet the surface and subsurface construction standards for a public water supply well

**WHEREAS**, the construction of tile or concrete sanitary sewer, sewer appurtenances, septic tanks, storm sewers and cemeteries is specifically prohibited within a 50-foot radius of any City of Zavalla Water Well.

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance permits the construction of homes or buildings within the 50 foot area as long as all items in Restrictions Nos. 2 and 3 are recognized and followed.

**WHEREAS**, this easement permits normal farming and ranching operations, except that Livestock shall not be allowed within 50 feet of any City of Zavalla Water Well.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1-** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption by a majority vote of the City Council of the City of Zavalla.

**SECTION 2-** Any person or persons in violation of Ordinance 71 will be fined no less than 250.00 per day and no more than 500.00 per day.
