

RESOLUTION NO. 23

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Zavalla, Texas, that the effective date of the proposed revision of rates and charges of Texas Power & Light Company for electric service within the City, heretofore filed with a Petition for Authority to Change Rates and Statement of Intent on January 4, 1980, is hereby suspended for a period of 120 days from February 8, 1980 in order to provide the City additional time for consideration of data supporting such request and for the conduct of public hearings in connection therewith; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the rates of Texas Power & Light Company for electric service within the City in effect on January 4, 1980 shall continue in force during the aforesaid period of suspension; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Secretary is hereby directed, promptly after passage hereof, to furnish a copy of this Resolution to Texas Power & Light Company.
