AN ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING THE UNLAWFUL GATHERING OF TWO OR MORE PEOPLE IN THE CITY OF ZAVALLA.

WHEREAS, the various law enforcement agencies have advised the City of Zavalla that a serious assembly problem has developed; and

WHEREAS, this practice results in unlawful acts being committed; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare of this City to authorize any law enforcement officer to dispell any unlawful assembly; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA:

SECTION 1. It is unlawful for two or more persons to assemble within the city limits of Zavalla when their actions are detrimental to the public interest, welfare, and peace of the Citizens of Zavalla.

SECTION 2. Be it understood their intentions and spirit of this law is to prevent public drunkenness, fight, abusive language, destruction of public property, disturbing the peace, and so forth.

SECTION 3. Be it further understood it is the intentions of the City Council to authorize any and all law enforcement officers to enforce said law.
