



ORDINANCE # 68

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A POLICE FORCE FOR A TYPE A
GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY.**

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code, Section 341.001 authorizes a Type A general law municipality to establish and regulate a municipal police force.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Zavalla has established that it is in the best interest for the safety of the Citizens of Zavalla to maintain a police force within the corporate city limits of the City of Zavalla.

THEREFORE, be it ordered by the City Council of Zavalla the City of Zavalla will maintain a police force of 4 paid officers and 4 un-paid officers.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or work in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of the Ordinance despite such invalidity.


AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #68
