

ORDINANCE # 41

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEEDS OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CERTAIN AREAS AS DESIGNATED

WHEREAS, the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation has made its recommendations to this Commission for such speed zone areas, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Zavalla has studied such recommendations and believe them to be realistic and proper for the City of Zavalla.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Zavalla in that the maximum speed for the areas applicable shall be as follows:

State Highway 63

From its intersection with US Highway 69 to a point 2,750 feet eastward, a distance of 0.366 mile, the speed limit shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour in either direction.

From a point 2,750 feet east of intersection with US Highway 69 to the beginning of the divided intersection with State Highway 147, a distance of 0.256 mile, the speed limit shall be forty (40) miles per hour in either direction.


From the beginning of the divided intersection with State Highway 147 to a point approximately 300 feet east of the intersection the speed limit shall be forty-five (45) miles per hour in either direction.

From a point approximately 300 feet east of the beginning of of the divided intersection with State Highway 147 (east end of intersection), to the Zavalla City Limits, the speed limit shall be fifty-five (55) miles miles per hour in either direction.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval and publication.
