**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TIME
LIMIT CONCERNING TEXAS PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT §552.275**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Zavalla, Texas has determined that it is reasonable and necessary to establish a reasonable time limit according to the Texas Public Information Act §552.275, concerning the amount of time to be expended responding to requests made under the Texas Public Information Act per individual requestor to the City of Zavalla, Texas.


NOW THEREFORE:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA,
TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Maximum costs allowable by law will incur for all Texas Public Information Act requests that meet or exceed thirty-six (36) hours of labor in a twelve (12) month period per requestor.
