
ORDINANCE #24

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FROM USING ANY TYPE OF FIREARM, (gun, rifle, etc..). IF A PERSON IS CAUGHT USING A FIREARM WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS HE WILL BE SUBJECT TO A MINIMUM CITY FINE OF \$23.50

WHEREAS, the City of Zavalla feels it is to the best interest of it's citizens to enforce and ordinance, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ZAVALLA: The City Council prohibits any person or persons from using any type of Firearm. If a person caught using a firearm within the city limits he will be subject to a minimum City fine of \$23.50
