AN ORDINANCE
REMOVING THE OFFICE OF CITY MARSHALL AS AN ELECTED POSITION AND
RE-INSTATING SAID OFFICE AS AN APPOINTED POSITION.

WHEREAS, the City of Zavalla has exercised it's option to
adopt Chapters 1-10 of Vernon's Texas Civil Statues in lieu of
Chapter 11; and

WHEREAS, it is permissable to appoint instead of elect a
city marshall under Chapter 1-10, V.T.C.S.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is to the best interest
and consideration of the City of Zavalla; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ZAVALLA:

SECTION 1. This ordinance decrees that the city marshall shall
hearafter be appointed instead of elected.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall supercede and null and void
ordinance # 6.

SECTION 3. The City Council, shall appoint a city marshall after
the present term expires april 1, 1978.

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Zavalla believes it is
to the best interest of said city for the position of city marshall
to be an appointed one. He shall be appointed and removed from
office by a majority vote of the City Council.
